Climate change is a growing problem facing our community, and Colorado is and is going to be heavily affected by it. Additionally, Colorado is one of the states that is doing the most in terms of climate change mitigation. As I researched the policies and actions the Colorado government was doing in regards to climate change, I noticed that one of the ideas they were emphasizing was environmental justice. Unfortunately, both the state and federal government's have not engaged in enough stakeholder engagement to properly create policy that supports everyone, and especially those who need it most. My goal is to understand this relationship. Based on this information, I decided to look into the difference between the opinions and knowledge of varying income levels. The goal was to get a wide sample of people from different backgrounds; however, the actual implementation of this was much more difficult than anticipated. I created a survey asking about participants' opinions and knowledge levels about environmentalism and general income level. I analyzed the collected responses with income level as the independent variable and the participants' answers as the dependent variables. I attempted to spread my survey to as many different people from as many different backgrounds as possible. However, my results do show a skew towards white women. My data has shown that there is sometimes a difference between the opinions and knowledge levels of people in comparison to their general income levels.
