Abstract (250 words or less):

My project is New Zealand mud snails and How Do We Get Rid of Them? My research focuses on eliminating New Zealand Mud Snails, an invasive species threatening the ecosystem in the South Boulder Creek riparian zone. These snails are a significant problem because they can drastically outnumber native species, with populations reaching up to 500,000 per square meter in just 2-3 years. They also consume valuable food sources for fish, leading to a decline in fish health and disrupting the entire ecosystem. Invasive species like these cost the world around \$423 billion annually. To address this issue, over one week, I tested ten different natural substances— baking soda, boric acid, cinnamon, citrus peels, coffee, diatomaceous earth, garlic, lime juice, salt and vinegar—on green algae, which is a major food source for the snails. I rated the samples against my control based on smell, water color and how much it harmed the algae. Baking soda was the most effective at not harming the algae or water color and with no noticeable odor.
